

# **ADMISSION PROCESS**

## **B.TECH I YEAR ELGIBILITY CRITERIA**

### **CONVENER:**

- Candidates must have passed or appeared in the Intermediate or its equivalent examination.
- Candidates eligible for B.Tech I year convener Admission Must Qualify TG EAPCET.
- Candidates should have Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry as optional or related vocational courses in the fields of Engineering and Technology in their Intermediate exams.
- Candidates should have passed Intermediate exam with 45 %. It is 40% for reserved category (SC/ST) candidates.
- Minimum age limit is 17 years of age as on December 31 of the year of admission. The upper age limit for these programs is 22 years.

### **MANAGEMENT:**

- Candidates must have passed or appeared in the Intermediate or its equivalent examination.
- Candidates eligible for B.Tech Management Admission Qualify/Not Qualify TG EAPCET.
- Candidates should have Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry as optional or related vocational courses in the fields of Engineering and Technology in their Intermediate exams.
- Candidates should have passed the in class Intermediate or its equivalent exam with 45 %. It is 40% for reserved category candidates

### **SPOT:**

- Candidates must have passed or appeared in the final year of class Intermediate or its equivalent examination.
- Candidates eligible for B.Tech SPOT Admission Qualify/Not Qualify TG EAPCET.
- Candidates should have Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry as optional or related vocational courses in the fields of Engineering and Technology in their Intermediate exams.
- Candidates should have passed the in class Intermediate or its equivalent exam with 45 %. It is 40% for reserved category candidates (SC/ST).

### **NRI:**

- Admit NRI /NRI Sponsored candidates who have passed the qualifying examination with not less than 50% marks in the prescribed group subjects or 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) equivalent to 5 on a scale of 10.

## **B.TECH II YEAR LATERAL ENTRY ELGIBILITY CRITERIA**

### **Convener:**

- Candidates should have a Diploma in Engineering and Technology or any other equivalent it recognized... by the State Board of Technical Education of Telangana State /Andhra Pradesh. If not, candidates should have passed a 3-year B.Sc. Degree examination with Mathematics as one of the subjects in the group combination from a recognized University in the Telangana/Andhra Pradesh state.
- Candidates eligible for B.Tech II Lateral Entry convener Admission Must Qualify TG ECET.
- Candidates should have passed Diploma in Engineering and Technology / Pharmacy/B.Sc (Mathematics) Degree as the case may be with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category SC/ST) for entry into relevant courses.

### **MANAGEMENT:**

- Candidates should have a Diploma in Engineering and Technology or any other equivalent it recognized... by the State Board of Technical Education of Telangana State /Andhra Pradesh. If not, candidates should have passed a 3-year B.Sc. Degree examination with Mathematics as one of the subjects in the group combination from a recognized University in the Telangana/Andhra Pradesh state.
